finished size 12³/₄" square

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- 1/4 yard each of two fabrics for squares
- 1 1/2 yards 3/8" wide grosgrain ribbon in contrasting color
- 1/4 yard fabric for binding
- Fat quarter (18" x 20-22") or 1/2 yard fabric for backing
- Two contrasting squares of felt for game pieces (enough to cut 5 X's or O's)

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

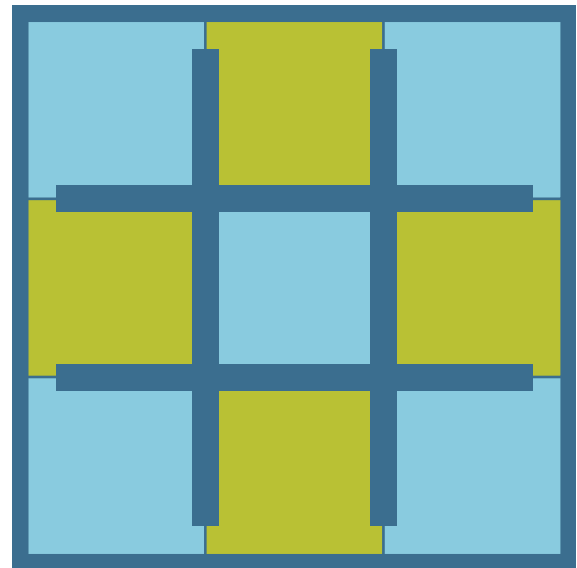
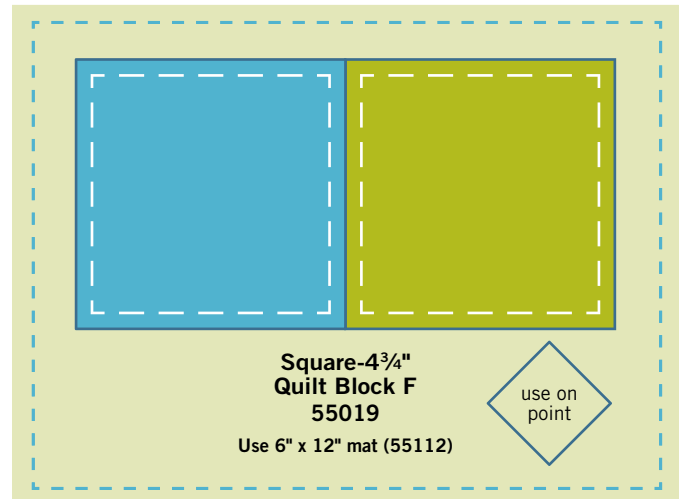
- Cut 5—(Quilt Block F) 4³/₄" squares of one fabric
- Cut 4—(Quilt Block F) 4³/₄" squares from second fabric
- Cut 4—12" long pieces of ribbon
- Cut 2—2 1/2" strips across width of fabric for binding

SEWING DIRECTIONS

1. Layout squares for mini quilt according to diagram.
2. Pin right sides together (RST) and sew squares together in horizontal rows.
3. Press seams of alternating rows to right or left.
4. Pin (RST) and sew rows together to complete mini quilt top.
5. Press seams open.

QUILTING & FINISHING

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Machine quilt with an all-over design.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
5. Topstitch ribbon over seams as shown in diagram tucking under ribbon ends.
6. Hand cut five each of 3" X's and O's from felt for playing pieces.
