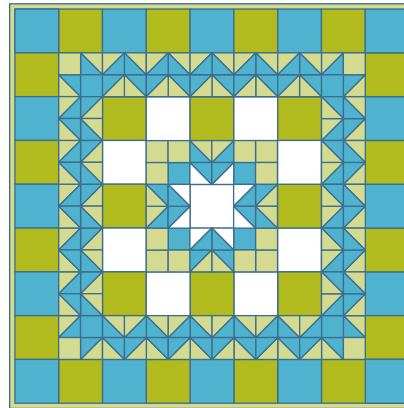



#### TRADITIONAL FABRIC REQUIREMENTS


-  Fabric 1—¾ yard
-  Fabric 2—1 yard
-  Fabric 3—¾ yard
-  Fabric 4—1½ yards
- Backing Fabric—1¼ yards
- Batting—40" square

#### CUTTING DIRECTIONS


-  **Fabric 1**  
Cut 9—4½" squares  
Cut 8—2" half square finished triangles
-  **Fabric 2**  
Cut 16—4½" squares  
Cut 8—2½" squares  
Cut 104—2" half square finished triangles
-  **Fabric 3**  
Cut 24—4½" squares
-  **Fabric 4**  
Cut 16—2½" squares  
Cut 96—2" half square finished triangles  
Cut 4—2½" strips across the width of the fabric for binding

#### SEWING DIRECTIONS


-  Pin and sew eight, Fabric 1 and Fabric 2, 2" half square finished triangles together. Press seams toward darker fabric.
-  Pin and sew 96, Fabric 2 and Fabric 4, 2" half square finished triangles together. Press seams toward darker fabric.
-  Pin and sew one Fabric 2 and three Fabric 4, 2½" squares together to make a 4-Patch unit. Make four.
-  Pin and sew two, Fabric 1 and Fabric 2 combined half square finished triangles together. Make four.
-  Pin and sew two, Fabric 2 and Fabric 4 combined half square finished triangles together. Make four.
-  Pin and sew combined units together as shown. Make four.


 Layout Fabric 1 and Fabric 3, 4½" squares as shown at left. Pin and sew together. Press seams toward darker fabric. Make two.


Pin and sew one combined unit to each side of center block. Press seams toward 4½" squares.


 Layout Fabric 1 and Fabric 3, 4½" squares as shown. Pin and sew together. Press seams toward darker fabric. Make two.

Pin and sew one combined unit to top and bottom of center block.

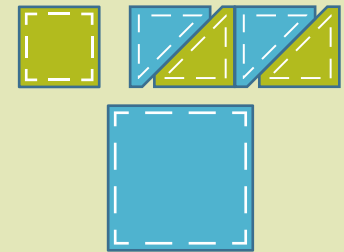
 Pin and sew two, Fabric 2 and Fabric 4 combined half square finished triangles together as shown. Make 20.

 Pin and sew two, Fabric 2 and Fabric 4 combined half square finished triangles together as shown. Make 20.

 Pin and sew combined units together as shown. Make 20.


 Pin and sew five sets of combined units together to form pieced border strips. Make four.

Pin and sew two border strips to sides of quilt center. Press seams toward 4½" squares.



Value Die-(square-4½", square-2½", half square-2" finished triangle)

Use 10" x 10" mat (55111)

 Pin and sew two, Fabric 2 and Fabric 4 combined half square finished triangles together with one each Fabric 2 and Fabric 4, 2½" square into a 4-Patch unit as shown. Make four.

Pin and sew one 4-Patch unit to each end of pieced border strip following quilt diagram for orientation.

Pin and sew one combined pieced border strip and 4-Patch unit to top and bottom of quilt center.

Layout Fabric 2 and Fabric 3, 4½" squares for outer border according to quilt diagram.




Pin and sew squares together into strips.

Pin and sew strips to quilt center to complete quilt top.



#### QUILTING & FINISHING


1. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Model was machine quilted with an all-over design.
4. Add 2½" strips for binding, mitering corners.

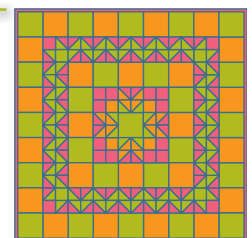
#### BRIGHT FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

-  Fabric 1—¾ yard
-  Fabric 2—¾ yard
-  Fabric 3—1½ yards
- Backing Fabric—1¼ yards
- Batting—40" square

#### CUTTING DIRECTIONS

-  **Fabric 1**  
Cut 16—2½" squares  
Cut 96—2" half square finished triangles
-  **Fabric 2**  
Cut 24—4½" squares  
Cut 4—2½" squares  
Cut 16—2" half square finished triangles

-  **Fabric 3**  
Cut 25—4½" squares  
Cut 4—2½" squares  
Cut 96—2" half square finished triangles  
Cut 4—2½" strips across the width of the fabric for binding
