### rectangles to GO! BABY QUILT finished size 42" square

#### FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- 1⅝ yards light colored fabric for rectangles
- 1¾ yards medium colored fabric for rectangles and binding
- 2¾ yards fabric for backing

#### CUTTING DIRECTIONS

- Cut 56—Rectangles-3½" x 6½" from light fabric
- Cut 49—Rectangles-3½" x 6½" from medium fabric
- Cut 5—2½" strips across width of fabric for binding

#### SEWING DIRECTIONS

1. Layout rectangles according to diagram.
2. Pin right sides together (RST) and sew rectangles together in horizontal rows.
3. Press seams toward darker fabric.
4. Pin (RST) and sew rows together to complete quilt top.
5. Press seams toward bottom of quilt top.
6. Trim sides of quilt top even with narrow rows.

#### QUILTING & FINISHING

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Machine quilt with an all-over design.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.

#### Quilter's Tip

Use AccuQuilt GO!™ Strip Cutter-2½" (55017) to cut binding strips!
